

Transportation Core Competencies



Strategic Deployment Coordinate and manage strategic common-user airlift, sealift, and terminal services worldwide.



Movement Control Coordinate transportation assets and regulating movements across a theater of operations.



Air/Seaport Operations

Receiving, processing, loading/unloading, and staging passengers, cargo, and equipment for onward movement to combat.



Motor Transport

Movement and transfer of units, personnel, equipment and supplies by vehicle to support combat operations.



Army Watercraft

Provide ship-to-shore and intra-theater lift support for maneuver forces and distributed sustainment in support of amphibious and riverine operations.



Rail Transport

Analyze rail network capabilities to support worldwide deployments. (USAR Only)



Quartermaster Core Competencies





Aerial Delivery

Pack and maintain personnel and cargo parachutes. Prepare/rig equipment & supplies for airdrop.



Water Operations

Purify, receipt, store, and distribute bulk and packaged water.



Petroleum Operations

Receipt, store, distribute, QA, and surveillance of petroleum products from refinery to end user.



Supply Distribution

Supply chain management of all classes of supply from acquisition to delivery to unit.



Subsistence

Field feeding of all Army Soldiers as well as the storage and inventory of food.



Mortuary Affairs

Recovery and tentative identification of fallen US service members and collection and inventory of personal effects.



Field Services

Provide field hygiene, laundry, and shower support for units. (USAR Only)



Ordnance Core Competencies



Maintenance Management

Provide integrated maintenance support of Army Materiel to include weapons, vehicles, and support equipment. Generate combat power and preserve equipment to ensure operational readiness.



Ammunition Management

Mange the supply, storage, transportation, maintenance, surveillance, inspection, and stock control of munitions.



Explosive Safety

Provide oversight to operations and activities where ammunition and explosives are stored and handled to reduce risk of potential mishaps involving military munitions.





Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD, 89E)

The EOD career field is an allvolunteer force designed to locate, assess, identify, render safe, and dispose of explosive threats to include conventional munitions, improvised explosive devices, and weapons of mass destruction. EOD Officer candidates will apply through HireVue during their commissioning cycle. Candidates will attend basic branch BOLC (OD/EN/ CM) followed by EOD school to be branch qualified as an 89E EOD Officer.
