70B Health Services Administration

Description of Duties: At the operational level, plans, coordinates, monitors, evaluates, and advises unit commanders and staff in both medical and non-medical areas of patient evacuation, treatment and tracking; preventive medicine, organizational administration, supply, training, operations, transportation, and maintenance. Duties are performed primarily in TOE and occasionally TDA organizations, both CONUS and OCONUS.

2LT to CPT Selection (0-4 years) - Time to Learn

Learn the Profession of Arms and Officership – Lead Your Soldiers.....PERIOD!

Speak with other officers in various AOCs

This is **NOT** the time to apply for LTHET! *(for 70 Series AOCs)*

Early to Midgrade CPT (4-8 years) - Time to Decide

Try assignments in various AOCs that interest you

Start considering LTHET options (no need to juggle your job and school!)

Speak with a Consultant(s) / Mentor(s) / HRC Career Manager

Seek Command...This is your Company Grade Super Bowl!

Complete Command **BEFORE attending LTHET* (unless you plan to switch to a Clinical-centric Career (i.e. PA, Lab Officer, Psych/MSW, MD))*

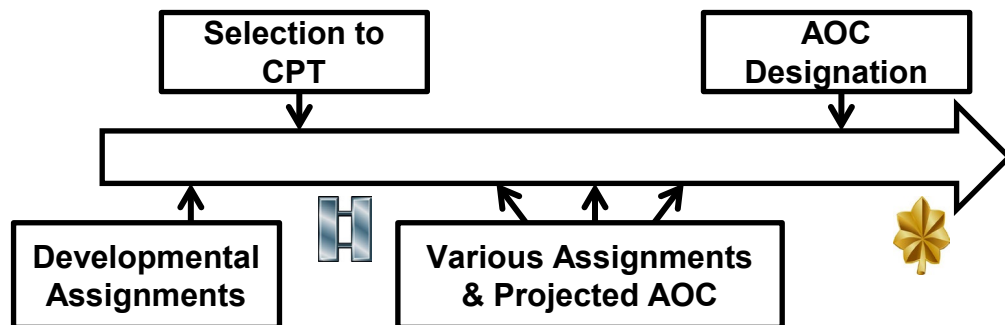
Career Field Designation Board (6-8 years) - Time to Designate

Year 6 & 7 are Opt-In: Do so only if you're confident in your career choice

Year 8: Mandatory designation for remaining 70B Officers

Three factors to determine AOC:

- **Acquired Skill Set and Experiences** (**LTHET selects**)
- OFM-Needs of the Medical Service Corps
- Officer's Preference

Assignment Expectations



Tour Lengths

- Standard CONUS tour length – 36 months
- Most OCONUS tours lengths – 36 months
- Broadening assignments, key leader and strategic billets – 24 months
- Korea, Sinai, Kuwait – 12 months
- Commands: 24 months
- Program leads, research, and faculty positions may require 5-year assignment
- **Bottom Line: Plan to be on station 3 years for ordinary assignment**

Readiness remains the #1 priority

- Medical Readiness – remaining personally medically ready to deploy
- Clinically competent – remaining ready to do the mission in your AOC

Separations and Retirements

- Retirements can be submitted up to 2 years in advance
- UQR can be submitted up to 12 months in advance, but NLT 6 months prior to separation
- Will be stabilized once the packet reaches HRC retirements/separations branch
- Active Duty Service Obligations (ADSO)
