



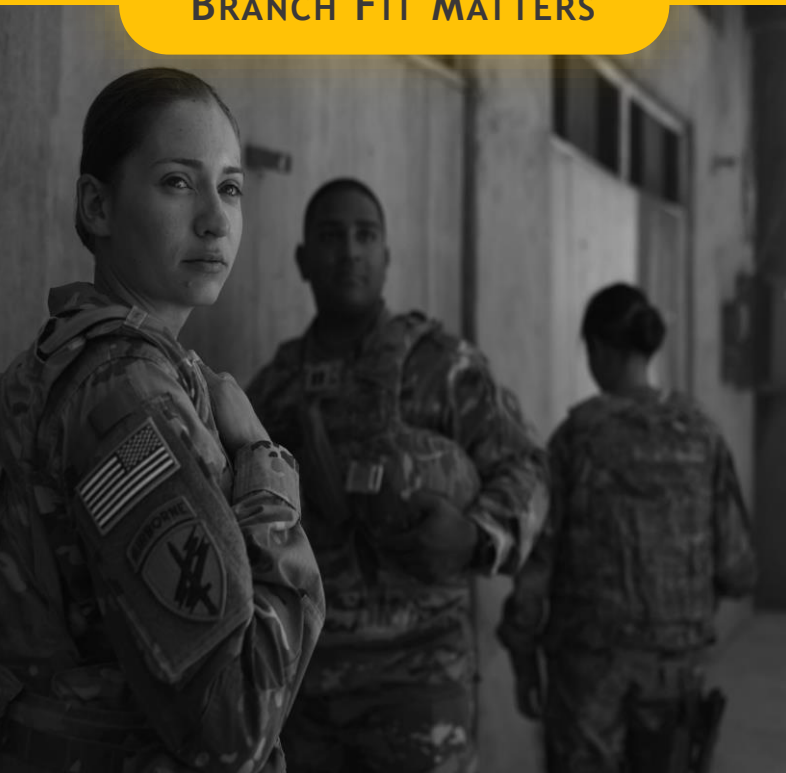

## **1. MENTALLY TOUGH**

- Stress tolerant and emotionally mature. Performs well even under extreme psychological duress.

## **2. INTERPERSONAL**

- Skilled in developing appropriate relationships. Able to connect with others to effect positive results.

## **3. INTERDISCIPLINARY**

- Synthesizes and applies knowledge from multiple disciplines into a coherent, overarching perspective.

## **4. PERCEPTIVE**

- Effectively discerns the deeper meaning or significance of one's observations (e.g., events, people and communication).

## **5. CROSS-CULTURALLY FLUENT**

- Aware of and able to operate across different cultural settings (e.g., geographic, demographic, ethnographic, generational, technological).

## **6. LOGICAL./ANALYTICAL**

- Uses reason and thinks in terms of cause and effect. Able to decompose and solve complex problems.

## SKILLS

Military Police (MP) officers are professional warrior police who are the Army's experts at combat policing, promoting the rule of law, and preserving the force both at home and abroad, across the range of military operations with a focus on readiness for protection, large-scale combat operations, and multi-domain operations.

MP officers are talented leaders of character who must deal with complexity in both garrison and deployed environments, applying investigative skills, adaptive thinking, and a detail-focused approach to their interdisciplinary career field.

MP officers must possess high levels of physical and mental stamina to operate under stress while skilled at establishing the necessary relationships in order to instruct, train, and educate across the various cross-cultural, ethnic, and human dimensional attitudes. They are articulate in conveying courses of action, communicating decisions, and accomplishing the mission regardless of operational constraints and environmental conditions.

# Intelligences

## INTERPERSONAL

- The ability to understand and work with other people. Requires a capacity to perceive and be responsive to moods, temperaments, intentions and desires of others. Can view the world from the perspective of others, have the ability to “get in the skin” of others. Excellent networkers, negotiators, trainers, teachers.

## BODILY-KINESTHETIC

- Intelligence of the physical self. Talent in controlling one’s own movements, as well as manipulating objects skillfully (craftsman, marksman, athletes, surgeons, etc.). Hands-on people with good tactile sensitivity, need to move frequently, often get “gut reactions” to things.

## SPATIAL

- Abilities to perceive, transform, and recreate differing aspects of the visual-spatial world. Acute sensitivity to visual details, capable of rapid visualization, ability to draw, sketch, and orient to three dimensions with ease.
